A weekly Tuesday morning prayer time for East Goshen men has continued regularly, at 6:30 - 7:00 a.m. During this period of construction we have met at different places in the building.

There is no structured leadership or input, but the time is spent in praying as a group. There is the conviction that prayer is often a neglected part of our individual and corporate lives. The core group is rather small and additional supporters are welcome and encouraged to attend, even if you can attend only occasionally--such as once a month. It is a good way to begin your day, whether you're on the way to work or are retired.
